

LLV School Operation Update as of Monday 23rd



Dear Village families,

Thank you for your understanding as we adjust on a daily basis to the latest advice on COVID-19. Here is what we know at this stage:

The Premier has stated this morning that NSW public schools will remain open until the vacation however, parents are encouraged to keep their children at home from Tuesday 24th March.

Tuesday 24th March will be that last day of face-to-face operation of The Bitter Pea café for this term. Lunch order deliveries will continue as per the normal arrangement and will include Friday. This operation will be reviewed at the end of the week, and is dependent on numbers.

For those students who need to attend school, we will be implementing the following measures to minimise risk:

Increased fresh air in learning spaces where possible.

Outdoor lessons are being encouraged

Tech Club and Boosters are postponed until further notice

Social distancing is being actively implemented

More supervised spaces available at lunchtime

Please note: Teachers will not be delivering regular lessons at school. They will be providing supervision for students to work on the same program of work as students will be doing at home.

LEARNING FROM HOME – As per my communication last week, the following platforms will be used by LLV staff to enable your child to continue learning from home:

K-2 – Activities sent via Compass. We will also be providing a work booklet for your child to work through at home.

Stage 2 – Google Classroom

Stages 3,4, 5 and 6 – Canvas

Please advise Stephanie if your child does not have a device or cannot access online learning from home.

How do I support my child to learn from home?

We encourage you to maintain a “normal daily routine” at home. Students should follow their normal school timetable by accessing the appropriate “course” for each session of the day. We will send the Primary timetable home to all parents of Primary students for your information.

Students should take recess and lunch breaks as they would in a normal school day.

Staff are currently working on other online learning opportunities including the possibility of video conferencing for some groups of students. We will continue to work on the best ways to support home learning over the coming weeks and will keep you updated.

Some Year 11 practical lessons may still proceed at school. Teachers will liaise with their individual students about these specific lessons.
