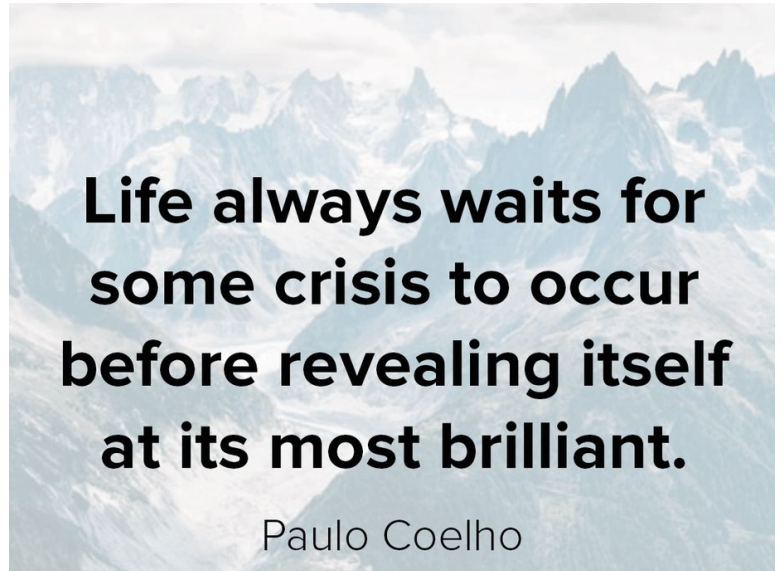


## Term 1 2020 Wrap Up
