Parent Drop Off and Pick Up for Week 4 days on site.

(New information in **bold**)

A number of students are still arriving well before 8.50 am and some even earlier than 8.20 am. The school gates will not be open until 8.20 am as there is no supervision prior to this time. It would be extremely helpful if children could arrive as close to the official start time as possible. Classes start at 8.50 am.

Unless raining, students will have to wait outside until 8.50 am in order to help us comply with the Social Distancing regulations. Parents are still NOT allowed on the school site at this point in

time. Even our littlest children managed really well without you this week and managed to get to the right places.

Our preference would be that if you can, you use Kiss and Collect. As per the usual Kiss and Collect rules, DO NOT GET OUT OF YOUR CAR. You should make sure that any car seats are installed on the left hand side of your car as children should not cross in front of or behind cars in the line.

Unfortunately, a number of drivers who may not usually use Kiss and Collect chose to make U turns and three point turns in the Kiss and Collect area. Not only does this put children at risk, it can actually incur a considerable fine and points on your license. Please keep everyone safe by abiding by the law in regards to driving in school zones. (We have attached a pdf which has more information should you require)

If you usually walk your children to school in the mornings, you will need to leave them at the front gate. Lou, Mark and Steph will be out and about to help shepherd students safely to the right place. If you would usually walk into the school grounds in the afternoons, you will need to wait for child/ren at Charles Bean Oval. Learning Guides will walk the students across for a 2.50 pm Primary pick up. Secondary students will walk to the oval for a 3.10 pm collection. Please be on time (but not early). We need to minimise the chance of having you wait in large groups together.

If your child/ren are catching the bus, we will escort them to the Bus Stop as usual.

What will the day look like?

As well as connecting and resettling, our connection days are being planned to continue to 'Unleash the Brilliance' within our community. Our teachers are building outstanding programs to facilitate this.
