

“A phased return to school”

What does that look like for you and your family?

As you would be aware, the landscape regarding how we manage COVID19 and the implications on schools is in a constant state of flux. We have used what we do know to build the following plan.

Step One

From Week 3, (**Monday 11th May**), we will be introducing the option to have each child attend school for **one** day per week. The primary function of this day is ‘connection’. As you can imagine, the logistics required to make this happen, whilst still meeting COVID19 guidelines, are significant. We have done our best to make things as uncomplicated as possible.

What happens on a connection day?

Initially, we will be helping students to resettle into school, reconnect with friends and make the most of being able to access resources, spaces and teachers in a face to face context. The focus will be on wellbeing, physical activity, making and connecting.

There continues to be only ONE workstream enabling students to work on their “Audacious” learning plan whilst at school. Students will be able to talk about their Quests or learning plan for the week, with their peers and a Learning Guide. Teachers will help students to make connections between the work they are doing and the learning characteristics. They will also support students to record their learning journey in their learning journals.

LLV Mobile Library



From Week 3, and to coincide with 'Connection Days', we would like to introduce the LLV mobile library. The library will visit learning spaces, giving students the opportunity to take books home and keep reading.

Parent Drop Off and Pick Up for Week 3 days on site.

Social Distancing regulations require us to put a series of measures in place in order to protect the community. Parents are **NOT** allowed on the school site at this point in time. We understand that this may be a little overwhelming but we will have plenty of teachers around to help get children to the right places.

It would be extremely helpful if children could arrive as close to the official start time as possible. Classes start at 8.50 am.

Our preference would be that if you can, you use Kiss and Collect. As per the usual Kiss and Collect rules, **DO NOT GET OUT OF YOUR CAR.**

If you usually walk your children to school in the mornings, you will need to leave them at the front gate.

If you would usually walk into the school grounds in the afternoons, you will need to wait for child/ren at Charles Bean Oval. We will walk the students across for a 2.50 pm Primary pick up.

Secondary students will walk to the oval or a 3.10 pm collection. Please be on time (but not early). We need to minimise the chance of having you wait in large groups together.

If your child/ren are catching the bus, we will escort them to the Bus Stop as usual.
