Futures Education - Immersion

Rather than asking "what will the future of work look like?", it's time to adjust our perspective to ask "what do I want my future of work to look like?".

This simple adjustment will allow the students at LLV to take control over their own future and become agents of change, rather than letting the world of work change around them.

As the students of LLV have been adjusting to Learning Goes Audacious, students in Stage 4 and 5 were given the opportunity to throw themselves into the current world of work, immersing themselves as they explore the skills and knowledge that they might need to succeed.

As the students reflected on their experience, and through their research, they stretched their imagination by creating the jobs of the future that they want to see.

One example of a job that was created was providing opportunities for community members with disabilities to provide mentorship to younger children or students with those same disabilities, providing both education and mentorship.
