



What's new in 2021!

2021 will be **'The Year of the Storyteller'** at Lindfield Learning Village.

We are already excited about developing our collective capacity as writers and storytellers.

FIRST DAY FOR STUDENTS

- Kindergarten will start full days at school on 3rd February. They will attend their Best Start interview prior to their first full day as arranged with the educators.
- **ALL Year 7, 11 and 12 as well as any NEW students only** from Year 1 - 6 and Yr 8 - 10 will start on Friday 29th January
- All other students in Years 1, 2, 3,4, 5, 6, 8, 9, 10 will start school on Monday 1st February.

New Bell timings (ha ha)

In 2021, we will have a staggered start to the day and will all finish at the same time. This should make transport easier for most families.

Year 7 - 12 will start school at **8.50 am** and finish at **3.10 pm**.

Year K - 6 will start school at **9.10 am** and finishes at **3.10 pm**.

The playground will be supervised from **8.40 am**.

Our day will be split into four learning sessions.

There will be one recess from **11.30 - 11.50 am** and lunch at **1.10 pm - 1.50pm**

Primary students will be given time during sessions 1 and 2 for snacks and body breaks as needed.

Transport

Kiss and Collect will be under enormous pressure as we increase our numbers and continue to manage the ongoing build.

For this reason we strongly recommend walking, riding, scooting or using Public Transport.

Please note that School Infrastructure NSW will be appointing a dedicated traffic and transport officer to LLV and are currently negotiating new school bus routes with Transdev. They are also working with Ku-ring-gai Council to install additional pedestrian crossings in streets close to the school.

If you must use Kiss and Collect please adhere to the following requests.

MORNINGS

Drop High School students no earlier than 8.40 am and Primary as close to 9 am as you can.

AFTERNOONS

Allow our youngest students to leave first by not arriving before 3.15pm unless you are **ONLY** collecting students in K - 2.

At **NO POINT** should you get out of your car. The educators look after getting students into vehicles safely.
