### Primary Job Immersion



As our Stage 2 and 3 villagers explore the worlds of Ancient Rome and the United Nations, not only have they increased their understanding of the life outside of LLV, they have also deepened their knowledge of themselves.

I've had the opportunity to come in to both Quests to run weekly Futures sessions, which narrows in on each individual student's enterprise skills that they are constantly developing here at LLV. These skills, such as collaboration, creativity and communication, will be needed regardless no matter where they go.

We were able to see what jobs the Ancient Romans needed to run an empire, and what the modern day equivalent would be. Similarly, we looked at the UN Sustainability Goals, and what jobs were needed to make them a reality.

### Shifting Mindsets - E-Portfolios and the ATAR

Back in June, the Education Council published a report addressing the changing nature of pathways from high school into future study and employment.

One of the main recommendations to come from this report was calling for the creation of a Learner Profile, which would incorporate not only a student's ATAR but also an E-Portfolio that captures the broad range of skills evidenced through a student's work and involvement throughout both school and the community.

As students work on their My Learning Journey, our most recent iteration of an E-Portfolio, they are recognising and equipping themselves with the skills and experience that they need to achieve success, regardless of where they might end up.
