Students will be able to vote on the best town design. There will be two winning teams, the 'People's choice award' and the 'Master choice award' (highest awarded grades) which will be announced on the day.

This will be a celebration of all of the hard work the students have put in throughout this term and we are excited to review their final products.

Unfortunately, due to Covid restrictions we will not be able to invite you all to review their work. However, we will take photos and provide you with a link so that you have the chance to view their work.

From Thursday week 9 the students will be engaging with a Science Fiction comparative film study. This draws in outcomes from English and Science.

At the end of the viewing, the students will work in groups to create a comparative review of the genre techniques and scientific phenomena which they will then turn into a vlog.
