

Travel Access Guide

Lindfield Learning Village is committed to providing students with safe, easy and sustainable ways of getting to and from school. Have a look through the options below for traveling to Lindfield Learning Village by train, bus, cycling, walking and driving.

Train and bus to school

Many school students are entitled to free travel on public transport between home and school.

A Child/Youth Opal Card entitles school students to half price travel on public transport in Sydney and surrounds.

There are two train stations within walking distance of the school.

T Lindfield Station is located 2.2km from the school (27 minute walk)

T Roseville Station is located 2.1km from the school (25 minute walk).

Both are along the T1 North Shore/T9 Northern Lines with around 12 trains per hour.

There are several bus services which connect suburbs of Lindfield, East Lindfield, Chatswood West, Forestville and Roseville with the school.

Check the map overleaf to see bus routes to and from the school.

LINDFIELD

B 565 Chatswood to Macquarie University service travels from Lindfield and Roseville Stations to the Eton Road Bus Stop outside the school (7 minute ride from Lindfield Station).

FORESTVILLE AND ROSEVILLE

B 284 Duffys Forest to Terrey Hills & Chatswood service stops along Boundary Street between Archer and Melnotte Avenue.

W It is a 2 minute walk from here to the bus stop at Pacific Highway before Wyvern Avenue.

B 565 Chatswood to Macquarie University stops at Eton Road Bus Stop outside the school.

CHATSWOOD WEST

B 256 Chatswood to Fullers Road service connects with bus route 565 at the Pacific Highway.

B 565 Chatswood to Macquarie University stops at the Eton Road bus stop outside the school.

EAST LINDFIELD

B 558 Lindfield to Chatswood service connects Lindfield train station and bus route 565.

B 565 Chatswood to Macquarie University service stopping at Eton Road Bus Stop outside the school.

Cycling to school

Riding or scooting lets children and teenagers get to school in a fun and active way. Check the map overleaf to find places where bikes can be stored safely during the day.

Children under 16 can ride on footpaths and primary students are safest when they are supervised by an adult while riding the school.

Walking to school

Students living around Lindfield, Roseville and Chatswood West could walk to school in less than 25 minutes, saving the need for drop off and pick up by car. Local buses are a backup for days when walking isn't as convenient.

Check the map overleaf for recommended walking routes. The school has been working with Council to provide a new footpath along Abingdon Road and new crossings near the school. There also will not be construction vehicles going to the school during school hours so that walking is safer.

Driving to school

Carpooling is a great way to share the daily school drop off. Parents, carers and older students are encouraged to get in touch with each other to make carpooling arrangements that suit them.

There is limited parking available at the school. Parents and carers can drive their children to school and drop them off at the school's Kiss and Ride zone. Check the overleaf for Kiss and Ride and Parking locations.

Instead of dropping children at the school, parents and carers could park at a safe location and walk the remaining distance to school with their children.

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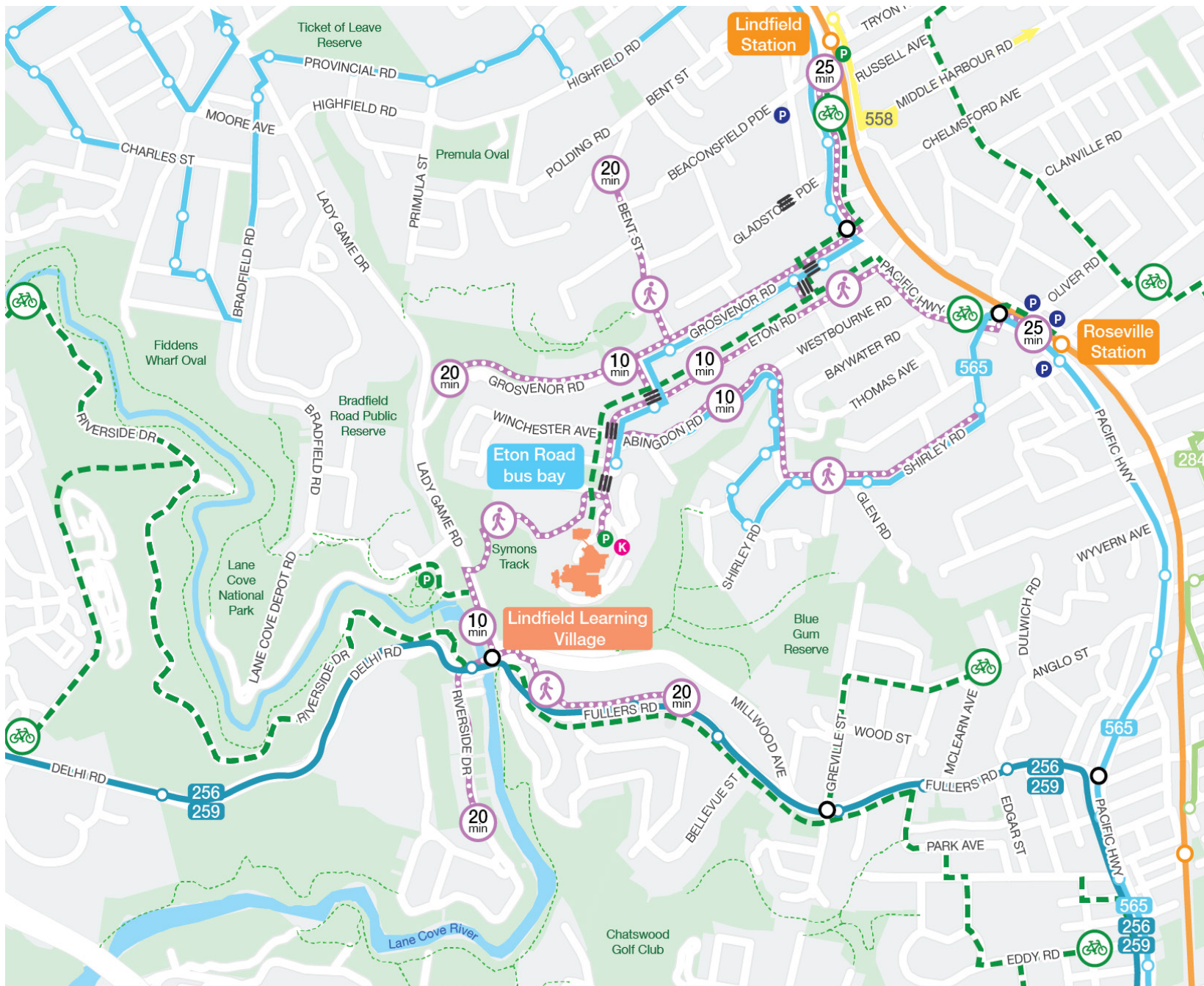
